Public Hearings (210185, 210452, 210364, 210472, 210597)

1. **210185: Recommend** (Niedergang) – Proposing an amendment to the zoning map to change 56 Murdock Street from the Neighborhood Residence to the Urban Residence district.
2. **210452: Recommend** LaCourt Foundation LLC proposing a zoning amendment to re-zone their property at 34-36 Merriam St to UR.
3. **210364: Recommend** 15 registered voters requesting the adoption of an amendment to the Zoning map to re-zone six parcels along Medford Street between School Street and Marshall Street.

4. **210472: Recommend** (Ewen-Campen) – Proposing zoning map changes to 8 properties on McGrath Hwy between 368 and 414 McGrath Hwy, as listed within.
